

NON EASA SPL LICENCES

Pilots flying in Spain with NON EASA gliding license (SPL), have to request to the Spanish Authority a temporary permission to fly under the EASA skies.

The medical certificate is valid as long as that document is valid in the country of origin for that type of flying license, nothing else has to be done.

We have the following cases:

1. Pilot flying a glider a glider with glider registration and pilot license from the same country In this case, the pilot has to request an Overflight Permit for the Spanish Airspace

2. Pilot fling an EASA registration glider

In this case, the pilot has to request a permission to fly an EASA registration glider in the Spanish Airspace

In both cases, the WWGC2023 organization is going to manage all permissions with the Spanish Authority. To request the permit to fly in both cases, we would like to ask to the pilots the following documentation:

- Pilot license
- Medical certificate
- Registration of the glider to fly

If any extra information is required, the organization will contact the pilots.
