- 2) Authority To Fly / Certificate of Airworthiness
- 3) Weight and Balance (No older than 5 years)
- 4) Aircraft Radio Licence or receipt of payment
- 5) Map
- 6) Sealed first aid kit
- 7) CAA Issued GPL
- 8) Release to Service document

The above documentation should be in your cockpit at all times and will be checked randomly.
