20 minutes by car

Bletchley Park, once the top-secret home of the World War Two Codebreakers, is now a vibrant heritage attraction in Milton Keynes, open daily to visitors.

[Duxford Aerodrome & Museum](#)

1 hour by car

Visit Imperial War Museum Duxford for a huge day out. See Spitfires take to the skies from the airfield where they first flew, get up close to gigantic aircraft and walk in the footsteps of the men and women who served here.

Away from the hustle and bustle of the safari park you'll find some peace in the treetops and as you swing and zip through this high rope challenge, enjoy the magical views over acres of animal reserves and beyond.

Woburn Lido

20 minutes by car

Small but lovely outdoor pool. Volunteer-run, pre-booking essential.

Woburn Village has a number of nice shops, galleries, cafés and pubs.

Waddesdon Manor (near Aylesbury)

40 minutes by car

A beautiful French Renaissance-style château with an extensive art collection, landscaped gardens, aviary and woodland playground.

Whipsnade Zoo

5 minutes by car, or a pleasant walk on the Downs!

Explore a world of wildlife like never before at Whipsnade Zoo – part of London Zoo, the largest zoo in the UK.

Whipsnade Tree Cathedral (on the Dunstable Downs)

Another pleasant 4km walk on the Dunstable Downs takes you to the Tree Cathedral, a lovely calm space. There's also a pub nearby ([the Old Hunters Lodge](#)) to have a sit-down before you walk back to the club.

Shuttleworth Collection (Old Warden airfield)

45 minutes by car

Come and enjoy the amazing gardens, follow the woodland sculpture trail and discover a unique collection of vintage aircraft, all set in 875 acres of parkland at Old Warden Park.

Mr Mulligans (Milton Keynes)

35 minutes by car

Indoor crazy golf, darts, etc.
